# **Recent Investments in New Technology: Enhanced Comfort and Communication**

Despite all the disruptions brought about by Covid-19, we have recently made a significant investment in new equipment to enhance our patients' comfort and to advance communication. This significant technological transformation includes new dental chairs, new lighting throughout the practice, new intraoral cameras and an automated translator.

Comfort is particularly important when visiting the dentist. To enhance our patients' experience at Convivial Dental, we recently upgraded our dental chairs in our Hygiene and Treatment Rooms. We hope you will appreciate the <u>new Belmont dental chairs and the updated lighting</u>.





#### **INTRAORAL CAMERAS**

Because a picture is worth a thousand words, we also recently equipped our Treatment and Hygiene rooms with <u>SOPRO</u> <u>CARE intraoral cameras</u> to educate and improve our patients' understanding of the condition of their teeth and oral tissues.

These are not simple video cameras. In addition to the high-resolution imaging, they offer advanced capabilities to identify dental caries and periodontal disease.



#### TRANSLATOR SERVICE



Communication is of paramount importance in healthcare.

To enhance our ability to communicate, we obtained advanced translating capabilities for our patients whose English is not their first language.

This equipment consists of an iPad connected over the Cloud with the <u>translating service AMN</u>. Now doctors, patients and their families can all speak through the iPad and easily address all concerns regarding their dental health.

This technology even supports live video translations for people who use sign language.
